<p>September 12, 2023</p> <p>FBI Overview and Legal Authority</p>	<p>This presentation will provide a general overview of the FBI and a legal overview explaining the FBI's authority and federal jurisdiction for investigations. It will highlight several investigative powers, such as search and seizure, and provide an overview of the FBI's deadly force policy.</p>
<p>October 3, 2023</p> <p>Active Shooter</p>	<p>This presentation will highlight the FBI's role in active shooter situations, law enforcement response, and how to protect yourself if in one of these situations. Additionally, the presentation will highlight some active shooter/lone wolf cases.</p>
<p>October 24, 2023</p> <p>Investigative Genetic Genealogy</p>	<p>A broad discussion on what Investigative Genetic Genealogy is, how it works and how the FBI utilizes the technique in solving various crimes, both cold case and current investigations.</p>
<p>November 7, 2023</p> <p>Civil Rights and color of law</p>	<p>This session will provide an overview of the FBI Kansas City Division's Civil Rights Program, which covers the following threats: Hate Crimes, Color of Law, and Face Act violations. The course will expose the audience to a basic overview of the FBI's response to reactive Civil Rights violations, FBI KCD's proactive approach to the Civil Rights Program to include community engagement and education for local law enforcement, as well as an understanding of the Federal statutes used to prosecute Civil Rights offenses.</p>
<p>January 30, 2024</p> <p>Intelligence in Investigations</p>	<p>This session will allow students to participate in discussions with FBI operational and intelligence personnel about assessing threats or warning signs of potential mass violence and learn about tools and strategies to analyze and mitigate these threats.</p>
<p>February 20, 2024</p> <p>Trial preparation and testimony with U.S. District Judge Bough</p> <p>Thompson Courtroom - UMKC School of Law – Ground floor</p>	<p>United States District Judge Stephen Bough and representatives of the FBI, U.S. Probation, U.S. Attorney's Office and the Federal Public Defender will engage students in a mock trial, highlighting the court systems, pre-sentencing investigation, oral arguments, and the sentencing process.</p>
<p>March 12, 2024</p> <p>Drugs of Abuse, Trends and Fentanyl</p>	<p>This presentation will focus on drug identification, education, and the signs, symptoms, and dangers of use of drugs and abuse. Nationwide trends and the dangers of fentanyl will also be discussed.</p>
<p>April 16, 2024</p> <p>Training &amp; Recruiting (&amp; Certificate presentation)</p>	<p>This session highlights the FBI's different career paths and internship opportunities, highlighting the FBI Agent and professional support hiring process. The session will provide an inside look into the many facets of these positions, including requirements, the testing process, and the multiple careers available.</p>
